- Understand why relationships are important in delivering business strategy,
- Understand the value of a pan-industry framework to enhance engagement and provide a benchmark for collaborative capability,
- Be able to link collaborative working to organisational objectives and constraints to promote both effective engagement and risk management,
- Be able to assess an organisation's internal capability as a prerequisite to external engagement,
- Be able to develop processes for the selection of partners,
- Understand how to facilitate the development of an appropriate delivery model and contracting arrangements for organisations seeking to engage partners in collaborative relationships,
- Understand the importance of continuous improvement, innovation and value creation to develop the relationship to its fullest extent,
- Appreciate the importance of effective measurement and monitoring of performance and the relationship,
- Understand the critical need to define the exit strategy to facilitate controlled disengagement.

Course Delivery


The **Collaborative Leaders** course is a full four-day course, delivered entirely in-person. Course content includes in-depth and interactive briefing on Collaborative Working and ISO 44001. During the course delegates are given the opportunity to apply the learning into their own business scenarios. Delegates are encouraged to work together to develop ideas, expand knowledge and expertise, and build on experiences. The course also includes professional development feedback.

Accreditation

The ISO 44001 Collaborative Leaders course is awarded by the Institute for Collaborative Working based on successful completion of the course. Course assessment includes: a multiple choice test (based on pre-reading - see below), the course exam, a group exercise on resource allocation, and an individual case study presentation. The exam is a three-hour closed book exam, assessed by Warwick University.

Content and Timetable

The course is held over four days. The course content for each day runs from approximately 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. Days 1 and 2 include opportunity for after-session study with the tutors. A group dinner is held on Day 3 of the course. Candidates are strongly encouraged to attend the evening sessions.



Preparation Requirements

To prepare for the course and enhance their learning experience, candidates are expected to have pre-read the following prior to attending the course:

- ISO 44001 Collaborative business relationship management systems Requirements and framework ISO 44001 can be purchased from Standards Australia
- ICW Paper Insight into ISO 44001 Meeting the challenges of the 21st Century the next evolution in collaborative working available on the ICW Website

Candidates are requested to bring the following to the course:

- A lap-top computer to prepare their presentations
- Material for the case study
